Dear Ambassador Karamat,

We, the Pakistani- American community in the USA, are writing to express our deep distress and anguish at the reprehensible crime committed against the person of a female physician, allegedly by Pakistani army personnel at Sui Gas complex run by P.P.L. Other Pakistanis in the country share our disgust and shame. It is obvious to even the most cursory follower of news that attempts are being made to cover up this crime. Sadly, this act of cover-up is indicative of the lack of regard the Government of Pakistan has for its citizens and their welfare.

We demand that a full and impartial enquiry be conducted, and its report made public immediately after submission, in its entirety, without any deletions or omissions. The culprits must be apprehended regardless of their rank or status and exemplary punishment permissible under law given to them. The agencies employing the miscreant must have punitive damages awarded against them.

ANAA has appointed a task force to look into this tragedy. The head of the task force has talked to the victim, and is in touch with Pakistan Medical Association as well as human rights organizations in Pakistan. This crime has struck at the heart of humanity. We are going to follow it closely and will not let this issue die down.
